Music publisher, Michael Nurko, president of Alpha Music Inc., has penned a deal with Talbot Perry Simons, president of American Patriot Pictures, LLC, and the producer, writer, director of the new motion picture “*Still the Drums*”.

Alpha will represent the latest remake of singer songwriter, Blind Willie Johnson’s old gospel tune “*Nobody’s Fault But Mine*”. The new version of the song is titled, “*Nobody’s Fault But Mine the P.T.S.D. Blues*” and it’s featured in the new film during a scene that leads up to the story’s climax. “*Still the Drums*” will have its world premiere screening at the New York International Independent Film and Video Festival on August 1st at the Regency Fairfax Cinema in Los Angeles. Three time MVP and Emeritus award winning jazz bassist Jim Hughart, who is currently touring with Tony Bennett, orchestrated and plays bass, with guitar soloist John Chiodini playing lead. Simons, a multiple award winning actor, wrote the lyrics, did the vocals and played the harmonica for the tune.

Nurko, who is the publisher of the original tune (registered with BMI), said that when he heard the new version of the song, which tells the story of a combat marine who is suffering from post-traumatic stress disorder, he decided to negotiate the deal to represent the song and connect with a major label to do a release.
